**Re: AS Examinations and Year 13 Studies**

The examination season is almost upon us and I would like to clarify the arrangements for Year 12 students over the next term.

**Students who have AS examinations should attend all lessons for that subject until all relevant papers have been taken.** Once all examinations for that subject are complete, students need only attend the subjects for which they still have examinations to take; or where they are taking a Vocational or Applied course e.g. BTEC, Cambridge Technical, using the rest of the time for revision.

Once all of the AS examination papers for the subjects being taken are complete, students need not then attend until the 'return date'. This year the return date will be **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June**, when students should attend registration and lessons as normal. Attendance on this date indicates a student's intention to carry on into Year 13.
